By Mr. Smola of Warren, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4448) of Todd M. Smola, Anne M. Gobi and Donald R. Berthiaume, Jr. (by vote of the town) relative to the appointment of David A. Powers to the position of fire fighter in the town of Ware, notwithstanding the maximum age requirements. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act authorizing the town of Ware to exempt David A. Powers from the maximum age requirement for applying for Civil Service appointment as a firefighter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law or rule or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of the applicant for
3 appointment as a Firefighter, David A. Powers of the Town of Ware, shall be eligible to have his
4 name certified for original appointment to the position of Firefighter in the Town of Ware
5 notwithstanding his having reached the age of 32 before taking any Civil Service Examination in
6 connection with that appointment. David A. Powers shall be eligible for appointment to the
7 position of Firefighter in the Town of Ware provided that he meets all other requirements for
8 certification and appointment to this position.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
