- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
- 2 of the same, as follows:
- 3 Section 26 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 4 by striking out lines 79 thru 84 and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- 5 (2) In the case of a police officer, such police officer while in the performance of his duties and as a
- 6 result of an assault on his person, or as a result of an accident, sustained injuries which resulted in his
- 7 being permanently and totally disabled. Should more than one applicant be eligible for appointment
- 8 pursuant to the provisions of this paragraph, said applicants shall be ordered according to their
- 9 respective standings.
