**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act authorizing the continued employment of Anthony Tranhese as an environmental police officer in the Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Anthony
2 Tranhese, an environmental police officer in the executive office of energy and environmental
3 affairs, may continue to serve in that position until he reaches 70 years of age or the date of his
4 retirement or non-reappointment, whichever occurs first. No further deductions shall be made
5 from the regular compensation of Anthony Tranhese under chapter 32 of the General Laws for
6 any service performed subsequent to his reaching the age of 65 and, upon retirement, Anthony
7 Tranhese shall receive a superannuation retirement allowance equal to the allowance to which
8 he would have been entitled had he retired upon reaching the age of 65.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
