In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act relative to licensing massage therapists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 227 of chapter 112, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 14, the word “nonspecific”.

3 SECTION 2. Said section 227 of said chapter 112 is hereby further amended by inserting
4 after the word “oil”, in line 15, the following words:- , kinesiology taping.

5 SECTION 3. Section 228 of said chapter 112, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
6 inserting after the word “event”, in line 28, the following words:- , whether on a single or
7 consecutive days.

8 SECTION 4. Section 235 of said chapter 112, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
9 inserting after the word “television”, in line 23, the following words:- or through electronic
10 means.
