**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act modernizing the Massachusetts alcohol laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 67 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 7, by striking the word “five” and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following words:- ten business.
