Message from His Excellency the Governor recommending legislation relative to validating a special election in the town of Westport.

An Act validating a special election in the town of Westport.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 10 of chapter 39 of the General Laws or any
2 other general or special law or town by-law to the contrary, all acts, proceedings and votes taken
3 by the town of Westport at its special town meeting on August 2, 2016, and all actions taken
4 pursuant thereto, are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed to the same extent as if the election
5 warrant had been executed and posted by the town in accordance with law.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
