An Act Designating a Certain Intersection Under the Control of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation in the Town of Bridgewater.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to designate forthwith a certain intersection in the Town of Bridgewater, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The intersection on State Highway Route 18 at its intersection with High Street in the  
2 Town of Bridgewater shall be designated and known as the Bryan K. McSheffrey Corner in  
3 recognition of Bryan K. McSheffrey's steadfast efforts to make safety improvements to the  
4 intersection of Route 18 and High Street. The highway division of the Massachusetts  
5 Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation  
6 in compliance with the standards of the department and as authorized by the Federal Highway  
7 Administration.
