An Act relative to duck hunting in densely populated areas.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. No person shall hunt fowl by firearm, arrow, or other means on the  
2 tidelands or 1,500 feet seaward from the shoreline at Revere beach or the Point of Pines beach in  
3 the City of Revere to ensure the public safety of the residents of the city of Revere and visitors to  
4 Revere beach and its use as a place of recreation and open space. Whoever commits any offense  
5 described in this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$2,000 nor more than  
6 \$5,000.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
