Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 172 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws has most recently amended by
- 2 Chapter 256 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended in subsection (a) by striking out paragraph
- 3 29 and inserting in its place thereof the following:-
- 4 "(29) Special education school programs approved under chapter 71B may obtain from the
- 5 department all criminal offender record information provided for in paragraph (3) of subsection
- 6 (a); provided, further, that the department shall provide said approved special education school
- 7 programs with criminal offender record information from other states made available to the
- 8 department and the federal government for the purposes of criminal background checks for
- 9 employees and potential employees of chapter 71B approved special education school
- 10 programs."
