The committee on Education, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 229) of James M. Cantwell and others relative to the transfer of funding for recovery high school summer programming; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 258) of Colleen M. Garry for legislation to establish parity in funding for regional vocational school districts and traditional public school districts; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2047) of James J. Lyons, Jr., and Michael S. Day for legislation to establish minimum funding levels for certain school districts; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2842) of Josh S. Cutler and others relative to the minimum amount of school aid available to municipalities; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2846) of Michelle M. DuBois, James B. Eldridge and Chris Walsh for legislation to establish an unfunded student reserve fund to be expended, without further appropriation, by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3553) of Natalie Higgins and others for legislation to establish a fund to be known as the education fund, reports recommending the accompanying order (House, No. 4672) ought to be adopted.

1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Education be authorized to sit during a recess of the  
2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 229, 258,  
3 2047, 2842, 2846 and 3553, relative to education.

4           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
7 on or before December 31, 2018.
