An Act designating a certain intersection in the town of Pembroke as the James “Tiny” Brown Memorial Square.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The intersection of Washington Street, Route 53, and Barker Street, Route  
2 14, in the town of Pembroke shall be designated and known as the James “Tiny” Brown  
3 Memorial Square, in memory of James “Tiny” Brown, who served his country in the U.S Army,  
4 served his town as a call firefighter and served his community as a businessman and  
5 philanthropist. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a  
6 suitable marker bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
