An Act providing for emergency cash assistance in response to COVID-19.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for emergency cash assistance in response to COVID-19, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department  
2 of revenue, within 30 days of the effective date of this act, shall deliver by first class mail a  
3 check in the amount \$1,000 to a qualifying household. For purposes of this act the term  
4 “qualifying household” shall mean: (a) 1 to 2 person households earning up to 84,000 annually  
5 or; 3 person households earning up to \$105,000 annually or; 4 or more person households  
6 earning up to \$131,000 annually, (b) household members who are Massachusetts residents as of  
7 the effective date of this act; and (c) filed taxes for tax year 2018 or if taxes were not filed in  
8 2018 can demonstrate their household income and household size through guidelines  
9 promulgated by the department.

10 SECTION 2. An additional \$500 per dependent shall be allocated to each qualifying  
11 household.
