An Act relative to the purchase of land for the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of Sudbury and the  
2 city of Framingham may expend monies in a Community Preservation Fund established pursuant  
3 to chapter 44B of the General Laws for the purchase of land for recreational use from CSX  
4 Transportation, Inc. for the extension of the Bruce Freeman rail trail.”
