**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the direct sale of alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 19 of chapter 138 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof, the following subsection:-

3 (c) A manufacturer may sell alcoholic beverages in kegs, casks, barrels, cans or bottles
4 for consumption off a manufacturer’s premises; provided, however, that such a licensee may sell
5 alcoholic beverages produced by the manufacturer for off-premises consumption.
