In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to postpartum depression screening.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 10K the following section:-
- 3 Section 10L. The division shall provide coverage of screenings by pediatricians for
- 4 postpartum depression in mothers of newly born children during any visit to a pediatrician's
- 5 office taking place for up to 1 year from the date of the child's birth.
