AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 5A of Chapter 71B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof
2	the following paragraph:
3	Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the department of children and family
4	services shall not make special education placement decisions and shall adhere to the current
5	individualized education plan until it is altered by the team process pursuant to applicable law.
6	Furthermore, the department of elementary and secondary education shall consider a special education
7	day school operated by an educational collaborative or other public entity as a different program type than
8	one operated by a private entity. A school district shall only be responsible for their portion of the costs
9	associated with a private residential placement pursuant to a valid individualized education plan.
