Text of an amendment, recommended by the committee on Ways and Means, to the Senate Bill relative to the transfer and sale of a certain parcel of land in the town of Tewksbury (Senate, No. 2384). July 27, 2020.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)

By striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:—

1 “Section 5 of chapter 153 of the acts of 2010 is hereby amended by striking out the words
2 “the proceeds from the sale of the Police Station property equally with the commonwealth” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- equally with the commonwealth: (i) the proceeds
4 from the sale of the Police Station property; and (ii) the net of any costs the town of Tewksbury
5 incurs to remove buildings from the Police Station property or to otherwise prepare the Police
6 Station property for sale.”.
