An Act relative to the retirement benefits of certain employees of the city of Chicopee.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 3 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, the Chicopee contributory retirement board shall permit  
3 Jorge Bracette, a member of the Chicopee contributory retirement system, to purchase creditable  
4 service for his military service time pursuant to paragraph (h) of subdivision (1) of section 4 of  
5 chapter 32 of the General Laws.

6           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 3 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, or any other  
7 general or special law to the contrary, the Chicopee contributory retirement board shall permit  
8 Mark Canty, a member of the Chicopee contributory retirement system, to purchase creditable  
9 service for his military service time pursuant to paragraph (h) of subdivision (1) of section 4 of  
10 chapter 32 of the General Laws.

11 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding section 3 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, or any other  
12 general or special law to the contrary, the Chicopee contributory retirement board shall permit  
13 Justin Clark, a member of the Chicopee contributory retirement system, to purchase creditable  
14 service for his military service time pursuant to paragraph (h) of subdivision (1) of section 4 of
