By Representative Soter of Bellingham and Senator Fattman, a joint petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Michael J. Soter and Ryan C. Fattman for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Kimberly Martinelli, an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Kimberly Martinelli.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of
2 Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Kimberly Martinelli, an employee of the
3 Department. Any employee of the Department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Kimberly Martinelli. If Kimberly
5 Martinelli terminates employment with the Department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Department.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
