## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to student data.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following section at the end thereof:-
- 3 Section 95. For the purposes of this section, the term "educational institution" shall mean
- 4 a primary or secondary school, a school district or a board of cooperative educational services.
- 5 Any person: (1) who provides account-based access to a website or an online service for an
- 6 educational institution; (2) who marketed and designed the online service for the educational
- 7 institution; and (3) who has knowledge that the online service collects data related to a student,
- 8 shall not use the online service to sell student data or to process student data in furtherance of
- 9 advertising; provided that the online service provider may process student data to provide,
- 10 improve, develop or maintain the integrity of its online services.
