An Act authorizing the town of Milford to grant an additional license for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General laws, the  
2           licensing authority of the town of Milford may, upon receipt of a completed application, payment  
3           of any applicable fees, after a public hearing and all due process, and in its sole discretion grant  
4           an additional license for the sale of wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on the premises  
5           pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138 to Central Gas and market Inc. at 186 Central Street in  
6           the town of Milford. The license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
