An Act relative to transgender equal rights..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSGENDER EQUAL RIGHTS.
- 2 SECTION 1. Section 67 of chapter 3 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 3 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "commission on gay and lesbian youth", in
- 4 lines 1 and 2, and inserting in place thereof the following words:- commission on gay, lesbian,
- 5 bisexual, and transgender youth.
- 6 SECTION 2. Said section 67 of said chapter 3, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 7 striking out the words "parent of a gay or lesbian person", in line 16, and inserting in place
- 8 thereof the following words:- parent of a gay, lesbian, bisexual, or transgender person.

- 9 SECTION 3. Said section 67 of said chapter 3, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 10 inserting after the words "sexual-orientation", in lines 19 and 20, the following words:- gender
- 11 identity or expression.
- 12 SECTION 4. Said section 67 of said chapter 3, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 13 striking out the words "gay and lesbian organizations", in lines 29 and 30, and inserting in place
- 14 thereof the following words:- gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender organizations.
- 15 SECTION 5. Section 67 of said chapter 3, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- striking out the words "gay and lesbian," in lines 45, 50, 52, and 56, and inserting in place
- 17 thereof in each instance the following words:- gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender.
- 18 SECTION 6. Section 56 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended
- 19 by inserting after the word "women", in line 44, the following words:-; people of diverse gender
- 20 identities or expressions.
- 21 SECTION 7. Section 32 of chapter 22C of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 22 amended by inserting after the word "gender", in line 12, the following words:-, gender identity
- 23 or expression.
- 24 SECTION 8. Section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended
- 25 by inserting in each instance after the word "sex", in lines 53 and 143, the following words:-,
- 26 gender identity or expression.
- 27 SECTION 9. Section 5 of chapter 76 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended
- 28 by inserting after the word "sex", in line 10, the following words:-, gender identity or
- 29 expression.

- 30 SECTION 10. Section 12B of said chapter 76, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 31 after the word "sex", in line 185, the following words:-, gender identity or expression.
- 32 SECTION 11. Section 1 of chapter 151B of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 33 amended by inserting after subsection 23 the following subsection:
- 34 24. The term "gender identity or expression" shall mean a gender-related identity, appearance,
- 35 expression, or behavior of an individual, regardless of the individual's physiology or assigned
- 36 sex at birth.
- 37 SECTION 12. Section 3 of said chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 38 in each instance after the word "sex", in lines 17 and 61, the following words:-, gender identity
- 39 or expression.
- 40 SECTION 13. Said section 3 of said chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 41 inserting after the word "women", in line 53, the following words:-; people of diverse gender
- 42 identities or expressions.
- 43 SECTION 14. Section 4 of said chapter 151B, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 44 in each instance after the word "sex", in lines 3, 69, 82, 87, 96, 103, 136, 163, 169, 179, 226,
- 45 233, 243, 339, 349, 353, 359, 474, 484, 494, 650 and 659 the following words:-, gender identity
- 46 or expression.
- 47 SECTION 15. Section 39 of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 48 amended by inserting after the words "sexual orientation", in line 4, the following words:-,
- 49 gender identity or expression.

- 50 SECTION 16. Said section 39 of said chapter 265, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 51 by adding the following sentence at the end of subsection (a):-
- 52 For the purposes of this section, the term "gender identity or expression" shall have the same
- 53 meaning as that term is defined in subsection 24 of section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-
- 54 one B.
- 55 SECTION 17. Section 92A of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 56 amended by inserting after the word "sex", in line 9, the following words:-, gender identity or
- 57 expression.
- 58 SECTION 18. Said section 92A of said chapter 272, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 59 by inserting the following sentence at the end of the second paragraph:-
- 60 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section or any other special or general law to the contrary,
- 61 all otherwise lawfully sex-segregated facilities, accommodations, resorts and amusements shall
- 62 grant persons admission to and the full enjoyment of such facilities, accommodations, resorts and
- 63 amusements consistent with their gender identity or expression.
- 64 SECTION 19. Section 98 of said chapter 272, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
- 65 after the word "sex", in line 2, the following words:-, gender identity or expression.
- 66 SECTION 20. If any provision of this Act is deemed invalid or unconstitutional, such a
- 67 determination will not affect the validity of any other provision of this Act.
