Jones, Jr., and others relative to the collection, use, disclosure or dissemination of personal information from customers of telecommunications or internet service providers, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 385) of Bradley H. Jones, Jr., and others for legislation to establish a student entrepreneurial and economic investment fund to provide an opportunity for interested students to gain entrepreneurial and early-stage business development experience and establish a relationship between the public higher education system and the business community, and the petition (accompanied by bill, House No. 4070) of Susan Williams Gifford relative to the issuance of licenses by the Massachusetts Gaming Commission in Bristol, Plymouth, Nantucket, Dukes and Barnstable counties, reports recommending the accompanying order (House, No. 5032) ought to be adopted.
