### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to promoting tolerance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That Section 32a of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended 2 to include the following:
- When activity or material designed to promote tolerance and respect, including difference in sexual orientation, when sexual implications are not discussed are exempt.
