8 Edition, is hereby amended by deleting, in line 7, the words "or for any term of years, but not
9 less than five years".

SECTION 4. Section 22A of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
Edition, is hereby amended by deleting, in line 14 and line 15, the words "or for any term of
years, but not less than 20 years".

13 SECTION 5. Section 23 of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
