**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act authorizing the Town of Ware to exempt Christopher Scott Romani from the maximum age requirement for applying for Civil Service appointment as a police officer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or
2 special law to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for appointment to the
3 position of police officer in the town of Ware, Christopher Scott Romani of the town of Ware
4 shall be eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police
5 officer in the town of Ware notwithstanding his having reached the age of 32 before taking any
6 civil service examination in connection with that appointment. Christopher Scott Romani shall
7 be eligible for appointment to the position of police officer in the town of Ware provided that he
8 meets all other requirements for certification and appointment to this position.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
