An Act to allow elected officers in the town of Lee to serve on the Board of Public Works.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 438 of the Acts of 1970, is hereby amended by striking  
2 out, in lines 12 and 13, the words "or any holder of an elected office in the Town of Lee."
