## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act updating gateway municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 23A of the General Laws is hereby amended in Section 3A by striking out-
- 2 "Gateway municipality", a municipality with a population greater than 35,000 and less
- 3 than 250,000, a median household income below the commonwealth's average and a rate of
- 4 educational attainment of a bachelor's degree or above that is below the commonwealth's
- 5 average.
