In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to unemployment insurance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 13 of Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby amended in the first paragraph by
- 2 inserting after the words “commissioner may prescribe,” the following: “provided that
- 3 employers whose contribution totals less than \$500 per year shall be required to report annually
- 4 rather than quarterly,”
