The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to mastectomies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 32A of the General Laws as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
- 2 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 17K the following section:-
- 3 Section 17L. The commission shall provide to any active or retired employee of the
- 4 commonwealth who is insured under the group insurance commission, coverage for the cost of a
- 5 mastectomy and coverage for a minimum of 48 hours in-patient care.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 175 of the General Laws as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts
- 7 of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 47DD the following section:-
- 8 Section 47EE. Any policy of accident or sickness insurance delivered, issued or renewed
- 9 in the commonwealth pursuant to this chapter shall provide coverage for the cost of a
- mastectomy and coverage for a minimum of 48 hours in-patient care.

SECTION 3. Chapter 176A as amended by Chapter 403 of the Acts of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting after section 8EE the following section:-

- Section 8FF. Any contract between a subscriber and the corporation under an individual or group hospital service plan, which is issued or renewed within or without the commonwealth shall provide for coverage of the cost of a mastectomy and coverage for a minimum of 48 hours in-patient care.
- SECTION 4. Chapter 176B of the General Laws in hereby amended by inserting after section 4FF the following section:-
 - Section 4GG. Any subscription certificate under an individual or group medical service agreement delivered or issued or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide for coverage of the cost of a mastectomy and coverage for a minimum of 48 hours in-patient care.
 - SECTION 5. Chapter 176G of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 4X the following section:-
 - Section 4Y. Any individual or group maintenance contract issued, renewed, or delivered within or without the commonwealth shall provide coverage for the cost of a mastectomy and coverage for a minimum of 48 hours in-patient care.
