An Act relative to state employment postings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 30 of Chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended in line 7, by inserting after the first paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:-  
4 “Every agency and institution of the Commonwealth shall transmit to the human resources  
5 division all employment opportunities, notices, and postings, excluding positions subject to  
6 section 46D of chapter 30, chapter 31 and chapter 150E, including but not limited to notices of  
7 job opportunities, new positions and vacancies. The division shall immediately place all such

8 information in the statewide employment computerized referral system. No position shall be  
9 filled without full compliance with this section”.
