**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court  
(2023-2024)**

An Act providing school building assistance for special education collaboratives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of Chapter 70B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking the following phrase:-

3 “Eligible applicant”, a city, town, regional school district or independent agricultural and  
4 technical school.

5 And inserting in place thereof the following:-

6 “Eligible applicant”, a city, town, regional school district or independent agricultural,  
7 technical school and Collaborative.
