**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act regarding school choice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12B of chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
2 following subsection:-

3 (p) Any student who chooses to attend a school outside of the district in which the
4 student resides by participating in the inter-district school choice program established by this
5 section, and the student’s parents or guardian, shall first meet with the school administration in
6 the district in which the student resides before the student leaves that district to discuss the
7 reasons for leaving the district.
