An Act relative to facilities grants for approved projects under the school building assistance program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (C) of subsection (a) of section 10 of chapter 70B of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Up  
3 to 6 incentive points may be awarded to districts located within municipalities that have adopted  
4 a smart growth zoning district or starter home zoning district, as defined in section 2 of chapter  
5 40R.
