An Act relative to the creation of a water supply system in the town of Rochester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the terms of Section thirty-nine A of Chapter forty, or any other
- 2 general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Rochester is authorized to create a water
- 3 district or water supply system pursuant to Section thirty-nine A of Chapter forty.
- 4 Section 2. Said system shall be managed, improved and controlled by a board of water
- 5 commissioners to be elected as provided by Section sixty-nine A of chapter forty-one.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
