## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act relative to improving the fair share employer contribution

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (a) of section 188 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the definition of "Employee" and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following definition:-

4 "Employee", any individual employed by an employer subject to this chapter for at least  
5 1 month, provided that for the purpose of this section self-employed individuals shall not be  
6 considered employees, and provided further that for the purpose of this section employees who  
7 are named beneficiaries receiving coverage on another's health insurance plan shall not be  
8 considered employees.
