An Act relative to reprogrammed human skin cells for embryonic stem cell research.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section . Subsection (a) of section 3 of chapter 111L of the General Laws, as added by
- 2 chapter 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby amended, in line 2, by striking out the words,
- 3 "embryonic stem" and inserting in place thereof the following word:-- skin.

- 6 "embryonic stem" and inserting in place thereof the following word:-- skin.

7 Section Subsection (b) of section 8 of chapter 111L of the General Laws, as added by chapter 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby amended, in line 8, by striking out the words, "Nothing 9 in". Section . Subsection (c) of section 8 of chapter 111L of the General Laws, as added by 10 chapter 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby amended, in lines 15-16, by striking out the words, "or 11 from donating their gametes for research." 12 Section . Section 10 of chapter 111L of the General Laws, as added by chapter 27 of the acts 13 of 2005, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (f) in its entirety. Section . Subsection (a) I of section 12J of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as most recently 15 amended by section 2 of chapter 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby further amended by striking out 16 the following paragraph:-For the purposes of this section, "fetus" shall include a neonate and an embryo, but shall exclude 18 a pre-implantation embryo or parthenote as defined in section 2 of chapter 111L and obtained in 19 accordance with said chapter 111L. 20 Section ____. Said section 12J of said chapter 112, as so most recently amended, is hereby further 21 amended by striking out after the word "neonate", in line 38, the following words:-, but shall 23 exclude a pre-implantation embryo or parthenote as defined in section 2 of chapter 111L and obtained in accordance with said chapter 111L. 24 Section . Section 12K of said chapter 112, as most recently amended by section 8 of chapter 25 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 15, the words

27	"implantation of the embryo in the uterus" and inserting in place thereof the following word:-

29	Section Section 7 of chapter 113 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section
30	9 of chapter 27 of the acts of 2005, is hereby further amended by striking out, in the definition of

32	donated in accordance with said chapter 111L."
33	Section Said section 27 of the acts of 2005 is hereby amended by striking out section 12 in
