The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act regarding Medicare savings programs eligibility.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, shall be
- 2 amended by inserting after section 25 the following section:
- 3 SECTION 25A. The division shall disregard income in an amount equivalent to one
- 4 hundred sixty-five percent (165%) of the federal poverty level, as adjusted annually, in
- 5 determining eligibility for the Qualified Medicare Beneficiary, Specified Low-Income Medicare
- 6 Beneficiary and Qualified Individual programs, described in 42 U.S.C. §1396(a)(10)(E) and also
- 7 known as the Medicare Savings or Medicare Buy-In Programs;
- 8 The division shall not apply an asset test in determining eligibility for the Qualified
- 9 Medicare Beneficiary, Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary and Qualified Individual
- programs, described in 42 U.S.C. §1396(a)(10)(E) and also known as the Medicare Savings or
- 11 Medicare Buy-In Programs;

- The division shall amend its state plan and promulgate regulations to implement said
- income disregards and asset test elimination.
