Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 19D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:- Non-
- 3 elderly handicapped and disabled people shall be mandated to live in separate housing facilities
- 4 from elderly residents. These handicaps and disabilities include, are not limited to, addiction and
- 5 mental health issues.
