An Act regarding school pupil transportation services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 44 of the General Laws as appearing in Chapter 44, Section (53 F1/2) is  
2 amended by adding in line 47, the following:

3 Furthermore, a city or town which has accepted the provisions of this section may in  
4 addition designate an Enterprise Fund under the control of the school committee for pupil  
5 transportation services.
