## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act pertaining to a firefighter apprenticeship program..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter 31, Section 59, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting in place the following section after Section 59:-
- 3 Section 59A. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule to the contrary, a firefighters
- 4 apprenticeship, training, and educational program shall be established for candidates for the
- 5 position of firefighter in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Furthermore, no person shall be
- 6 eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in a city
- 7 or town in the Commonwealth until such candidate has successfully passed the "Firefighters
- 8 Apprenticeship Program. The Firefighters Apprenticeship Program shall be funded by the

9	Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the cities, towns, authorities and fire districts therein, the
10	Federal Government, and the candidates in the apprenticeship program."
