**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act to clarify comparable health care coverage.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 18 of Chapter 15A of the General Laws, as most recently amended
2 by chapter 35 of the acts of 2013, is hereby further amended by inserting, after the words
3 "providing comparable coverage", the following phrase: -

4 provided that such institution shall allow students to waive participation in its student
5 health insurance program if the student can demonstrate current participation in an organization
6 defined in 26 U.S.C. Sec. 5000A(d)(2)
