## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to campaign finance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 18 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out the second to last paragraph, contained in lines 347 to 354,
- 3 inclusive, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:- Candidates who have no
- 4 political committee organized on their behalf and who have not received any campaign
- 5 contributions, incurred any liabilities, nor expended money on their behalf during any reporting
- 6 period shall not be required to sign an affidavit stating that they have not received a campaign
- 7 contribution, incurred any liabilities, nor made any expenditure on their own behalf.
