An Act to promote sustainability of state-subsidized family childcare.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 9 of Chapter 15D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2019
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following new sub-section (d):
- The department shall establish a fund entitled the Family Childcare Sustainability Fund.
- 4 Said fund shall be used to reimburse family childcare providers for the income lost as a result of
- 5 the cessation of state-subsidized childcare services pending investigation or appeal, including
- 6 appeals pursuant to the regulations of the department and those of the department of children and
- families, administrative appeals, and appeals pursuant to chapter 30A and section 10 of this
- 8 chapter, where allegations of abuse or neglect are not substantiated or are determined to be
- 9 unfounded.
