In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to promote regionalization with watershed based permitting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of environmental protection shall conduct a feasibility study for the 2 implementation of watershed-based permitting. The department shall complete a report of its 3 findings within 1 year of the effective date of this act. A copy of the report shall be provided to 4 the governor, the clerks of the senate and the house of representatives, the chairs of the house 5 and senate committees on ways and means and the joint committee on environment, natural 6 resources and agriculture.
