An Act relative to the possession of weapons.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 170 of the Acts of 2004 is hereby amended in section 1 by striking  
2 “federal, state or municipal” in each instance where it occurs and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following: “federal, state, county or municipal”.

4 Section 2. Said chapter is hereby amended in section 2 by striking the words, “state police and  
5 municipal police” and inserting in place thereof the following: “state, county and municipal law  
6 enforcement agencies”.
