The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to certain option B and option C retirees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, a  
2 member who is receiving a lesser retirement allowance in accordance with the terms of Option a  
3 as of July 1, 2000, Option b or Option C of Subdivision of Section (to be filled in by filer) of  
4 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, from a retirement system that accepts the provisions of this act,  
5 shall have his retirement allowance determined according to the table of mortality selected by the  
6 commission pursuant to Section 336 of Chapter 47 of the Acts of 2004 and whatever section  
7 governs the Option B amount. For purposes of the Act, the State Teachers' and State Employees'  
8 Retirement Systems shall be deemed to have accepted the provisions of this act
