An Act relative to affordable housing units.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official

2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the section 20 the following section:-
