The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to protect the right whale and other endangered sea life.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the

2 following section:-

3 "Section 2GGGG Right Whale and Endangered Sea Life Research and Protection Fund."

4 Section 2. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth a

5 separate fund to be known as the Right Whale and Endangered Sea Life Research and Protection

6 Fund, the funds of which shall be expended by the division of coastal zone management within

7 the executive office of energy and environmental affairs for the purpose of purchasing or leasing

8 equipment, vessels and technologies to diminish fatalities of right whales, sea turtles and other

9 endangered sea life in Massachusetts coastal waters, including support of efforts by the Northeast

10 Implementation Team and its member organizations. Said division shall establish a grant program to expend said funds and shall give priority to public institutions of higher education 11 and non-profit corporations located within the Commonwealth, including, but not limited to 12 woods hole oceanographic institute, the center for coastal studies, new england aquarium and 13 other entities with established records of right whale and endangered sea life research for 14 15 purchasing or leasing equipment, information technology and marine vessels. Said division shall 16 prioritize the expenditure of said funds on developing data related to the interaction of northern right whales and endangered sea life and vessels transitting cape cod bay and the great south 17 channel, improvements to the mandatory ship reporting system, improvements to fishing and 18 lobstering gear, improvements to the remote monitoring of right whales and the development of 19 acoustical and optical systems to diminish right whale and endangered sea life fatalities. 20

21 The Right Whale Research and Protection Fund shall receive monies from: (1) gifts, 22 grants, appropriations and donations from public or private sources; (2) federal reimbursements 23 and grants-in-aid; (3) any interest earned from the fund; and (4) the proceeds of special obligation bond sales by the commonwealth, denoted as the Right Whale Research and 24 Protection Loan Act of 2016. The state treasurer shall receive, deposit and invest funds held in 25 such a manner as to ensure the highest interest rate available consistent with the safety of the 26 27 fund. The books and records of the fund shall be subject to an annual audit by the state auditor. The division of coastal zone management may expend such funds, in addition to appropriation, 28 and no expenditure from the fund shall cause it to be in deficiency at the close of a fiscal year. 29 30 The director of coastal zone management shall report annually to the house and senate committees on ways and means and the joint committee on natural resources and agriculture on 31

income received into the fund and the sources of that income, any expenditures from the fundand their purposes and fund balances.

34 SECTION 3. To meet a portion of the expenditures necessary in carrying out the provisions of section 2GGGG of chapter 29 of the General Laws, the state treasurer shall, upon 35 request of the governor, issue and sell bonds of the commonwealth in an amount to be specified 36 by the governor from time to time, but not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of \$5,000,000 to 37 38 be in addition to those bonds previously authorized and which authorizations remain uncommitted or unobligated on the effective date of this act. All bonds issued by the 39 commonwealth as aforesaid shall be designated on their face, Commonwealth of Massachusetts 40 41 and the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs Right Whale and Endangered Sea Life Research and Protection Loan Act of 2016, and shall be issued for a maximum term of years, not 42 43 exceeding 20 years, as the governor may recommend to the general court pursuant to Section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth; provided, 44 however, that all such bonds shall be payable not later than June 30, 2036. All interest and 45 payments on account of principal of such obligations shall be payable from the General Fund. 46 Bonds and interest thereon issued under the authority of this section shall be general obligations 47 of the commonwealth. 48
