*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 Section (h), paragraph 1 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition is
- 3 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:
- 4 Any member who is a Veteran, as defined in Section 1 of said Chapter 115 as amended, who
- 5 retired prior to
- 6 January 1996, may be granted creditable service for service to the Commonwealth or any
- 7 municipality or county and

8 such service may be compensated in a manner deemed acceptable by the retirement system with

9 jurisdiction over

10 said retiree.
